Safeguarding – Attitudes and Behaviour

At school the children and staff all follow **THINK**. This can show be to share something positive or at times when we may have made a poor choice we discuss it in the following way.

Truth – have you shared the truth?

Helpful – were your actions helpful?

Inspiring – did your actions inspire others?

Necessary – were your actions necessary?

Kind – Did your actions show kindness?

We also use **See it, Hear it, Say it, Stop it.**

Pupils, staff and visitors to school know that if they see or hear something that is inappropriate they can tell (say it) any adult who will then help in stopping anything that is not acceptable.

Every child has a named Trusted Adult who they know they can share anything with. As members of our school community you too can access the staff to share any worries or concerns.

Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility.
