NATIONAL SCIENCE WEEK

This week has been a busy week - its Science Week! On Thursday, Miss Wood, Mrs Pettigrew and Mr Henvey took 14 children from across Key Stage 2 to the Black Country Museum for a Chemistry at Work day in celebration of British Science Week. We looked at Chemistry in the real world, explored copper and other metals, tried out some photochemistry testing if something was fluorescent or phosphorescent, and even extracted our own DNA! It was an exciting day and the staff from the Black Country commented on how well behaved the children were! We have had live lessons from the National Farmers Union about 'connection'. How are tractors connected to space? How are pigs connected to Jumbo Jets? How are sheep connected to seaweed? Interesting questions that we managed to find some answers to! Year 6 led some experiments across the school - we made rain! We experimented and investigated in our own classes. Watch out because we have some very talented budding scientists in our school!


