

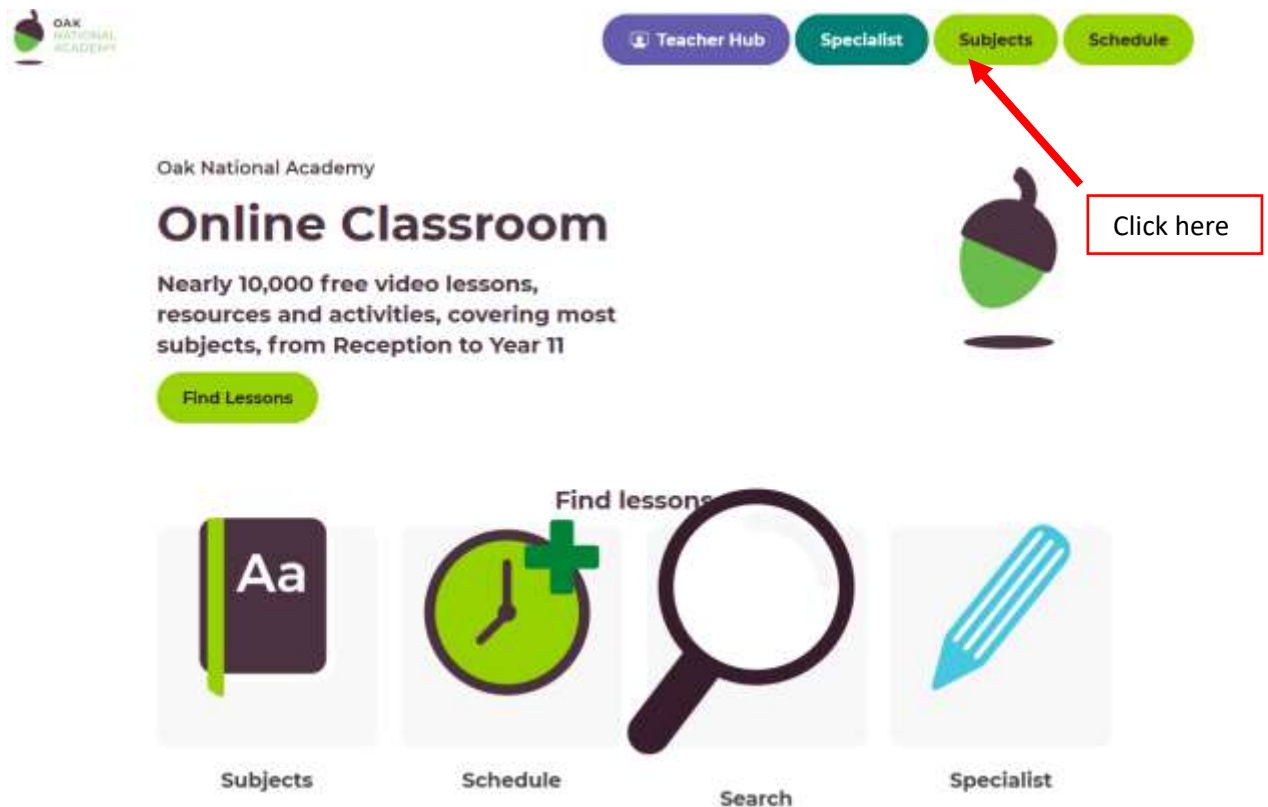
Oak National Academy Step by step Guide – KS2
