Parent Responsibilities

We will ensure:

1. That our child can actively participate in the Church's teaching and will encourage our child to attend school led Family Masses.
2. That we will make sure our child arrives promptly for school before 8.40am each day and is absent only when necessary. We will be at school promptly for 3.00pm to collect our child each day.
3. That we will inform our school either by phone before 8.30am, on the day of absence.
4. That we will support our child's learning including completion of homework and reading at home.
5. That we will work in partnership with the staff of Holy Souls to enable our child to develop to his/her full potential.
6. That we will support the school in maintaining a high standard of behaviour, through the schools Discipline and Behaviour Policy.
7. That we will support the school policy for wearing of uniform and PE kit.
8. That we will contact the school if we or our child have any concerns, particularly if that concern is about another child, parent or guardian.
9. That we will attend all parental consultations to discuss our child's progress and any other meetings or workshops requested by school.
10. We shall keep Mallard Close as safe as possible for all our children by stopping/parking vehicles only in a legal manner.
