

**KS1 Curriculum Overview Year Group: 2****Term: Summer 2**

<b>RE</b>	The Church-The children will learn about the roles and responsibilities in our church. They will also learn about the symbols and artefacts that help people to pray in church. The Mass- The children will learn about Mass and the order of their special celebration and the significance of the words, actions and artefacts used by the priest. One World Week~ Faith: Hinduism ~Holi and Diwali
<b>English</b>	The children will be writing alternative stories. The children will learn poems and discuss what they like/dislike about poems. They will also write their own poems and perform them to an audience. They will describing settings and writing facts about lighthouses. In reading they will focus on non-fiction and poetry and being able to use the correct vocabulary to explain. They will also revisit all the grammar skills taught this year.
<b>Maths</b>	This half term we will be reviewing all of our learning this year. The children will focus on the four operations and using the inverse to find an answer. They will also look in more detail at shape and measure and solving problems using time and length. We will have opportunities to solve problems, reason and explain our learning.
<b>Science</b>	Scientific study of different scientists.
<b>History</b>	The children will compare seaside holidays now and in the past and how travel has opened up the world for more people to go to different countries.
<b>Geography</b>	The children will continue on work on Tocuaro and compare school life and village live with our school and Acocks Green. They will also learn about the UK seaside and use vocabulary linked to the physical and human geography of these areas.
<b>Computing</b>	This half term the children will be looking in more detail at E-Safety when we are online. They will look at how we can be safe when we are online and what to do if we feel unsafe.
<b>Art</b>	They will use colour and the knowledge of symmetry to design and make a Mexican mask, linked to the village of Tocuaro in Mexico. During Multi faith week, children will design rangoli patterns, mendhi, and make Diya lamps.
<b>DT</b>	Food technology: Children will prepare fruit and vegetables to make a healthy snack.
<b>PE</b>	Cricket- developing the skills we have learnt in our games unit. To be able to play effectively.
<b>Music</b>	The children will use their voices to express and create songs, chants and rhymes. Play instruments and experiment with creating different sounds. They will revisit favourite songs and use musical vocabulary to talk about them. They will also listen to the music The Syncopated Clock ~Leroy Anderson.
