

KS2 Curriculum Overview Year Group: 3 Term: Summer 2

RE	<p>Unit 6 - Prayer Know that Jesus valued his relationship with God his Father in prayer. Understand that people can pray in different ways and be able to talk about different styles of prayer and some symbols used to help people to pray.</p> <p>World faiths: Study of Hinduism - beliefs and traditions.</p>
English	<p>Traditional tales: Little Red Riding Hood Poetry: The Magic Box <u>Non-fiction</u> - information text - volcanoes Grammar and Punctuation: Sentence punctuation. Using speech marks. Using 'a' or 'an' depending on what the next word begins with. Spellings: Topic related words, high frequency words and words taken from National Curriculum words list (Y3/4).</p>
Maths	<p>Measurement: Measuring using millilitres and litres. Read and write time using 12 and 24 hour.</p> <p>Geometry: Shape: identifying horizontal, vertical, and curved lines.</p> <p>Statistics: Construct and interpret bar charts using scales</p>
History/Geography	<p>Describe and understand climate, rivers, mountains, volcanoes, earthquakes, settlements, trade links etc.</p>
Science	<p>Rocks: Compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties. Describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock. Recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.</p>
PE	<p>Swimming Games/Striking and fielding/athletics</p>
Computing	<p>Coding using Scratch and Purple Mash. Sequence, select and use repetition in programs using input and output. Research for information text</p>
Art & Design	<p>Making volcanoes</p>
