

# Reception Parent Information Sheet. Spring Term 2022



## **Happy New Year and Welcome back!**

A few reminders and logistical changes for the Term ahead.

Now that Reception has transitioned well into School life and daily routine, your child is now is a permanent member of either;

**RT** ~ with Mrs Taylor as their Teacher and support from Mrs Syposz and Miss Marshman  
or

**RK** ~ with Mrs Leedham (Mon and Tues) and Mrs Keane (Wed, Thurs, Fri) as their Teacher and support from Mrs Hassett and Mrs O'Neill.

**RT** will enter and exit from the first classroom (closest to gate)

**RK** will enter and exit from the second classroom (furthest from the gate)

### **Home School Communication**

As always, please let us know if someone different will be picking your child up from school. If you require a conversation with your child's teacher, you can contact them via the Dojo platform, which we check in on daily or please call or email the school office. Your child's teacher will contact you as soon as possible. If your child's teacher needs to contact you then they will make a phone call.

### **PE**

PE will continue to be taught on **Tuesdays**, your child can come to school in their school PE kit on a Tuesday. In colder weather they can wear navy blue coloured tracksuit bottoms or leggings with their white polo t-shirt and School jumper or cardigan.

### **Forest School**

Forest School will take place **every Monday** so all children will need wellies and if possible, waterproof/ protective outdoor wear. Children can wear their PE kits (as above).

The children are welcome to leave their wellies and waterproofs in school if you prefer.

### **Book Bag Reminder**

Following the recent letter sent out about our new Reading and Phonics scheme, we ask that children bring book bags in every day, their books will be changed weekly. In them should include their 2x Reading books, Word List booklet and Number booklet.

Please send your child to school with drink bottle, preferably water but water or cordial only, and a piece of fruit. Please cut grapes in half if this is the fruit that you provide. A clean pair of pants is also good to have in your child's book bag in case of accidents.

Please do not send in any toys from home.
