Welcome back to another busy school year. Your children have made a great start to Year 3 and are beginning to become familiar with the routines. The following information should help you support them over the coming year and answer any questions you may have.

Homework

Children should aim to **read** their home reading book for 20 minutes every day. Please sign their diary each evening and send it back into school with them. They change their own book independently as needed.

Your child will receive maths homework electronically on a weekly basis. This will be via MyMaths.

Spellings will also be electronic and tested on a weekly basis. Throughout the year, the children will also be expected to learn the Year 3/4 Statutory Spellings, which will be sent home.

The children will have a Mental Maths test each week. Please encourage your children to practice their times tables on TTRS (Times Table Rock Stars). All logins will be sent home and emailed.

There will be occasional RE/Science/History/Geography/Art homework set to support the topic we are working on.
