They will focus on these skills:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Use knowledge of morphology & etymology in spelling •Develop legible personal handwriting style •Plan writing to suit audience & purpose; use models of writing •Develop character & setting in narrative •Select grammar & vocabulary for effect (this links with the grammar listed above) •Use a wide range of cohesive devices •Ensure grammatical consistency
